i. Oral Presentation

Presentation can be either in English or Malayalam.

The time allocated for oral presentation is 7 minutes, and 2 minutes for discussion.

All the Malayalam language presentation slides should be in pdf format.

A maximum of three members can form a group for oral presentation.

For oral Presentation power point presentation or charts can be used

ii. Poster Presentation

Poster can be either in English or Malayalam.

Poster must be in portrait, poster size A0 (84 cm wide x 119 cm high).

Title, name of team members and name of the school must be clearly written on the top of the poster.

Information on the poster should flow from left to right and from top to bottom.

Keep poster simple – avoid too much information.

Double space all text, using left justification.

Use photos, graphs, tables etc wherever necessary.

All information should be large enough to be read easily Suggested text size is at least 24 point; author(s) and affiliation(s) should be at least 42 point; subheadings should be at least 60 point.

Only one student is allowed to present the poster.

These rules are applicable to posters of focal theme, sub themes, My farm and My school farm presentations.

Quiz competition

A team consists of 2 students. Quiz competitions are conducted for three categories, viz Sub Junior (UP), Junior (HS) and Senior (HSS and VHSE). A school can send only one team each for junior and senior levels.

There will be an objective type written examination to short list the team for the final round.

Painting competition

Painting competitions are conducted three categories, viz Sub Junior (UP), Junior (HS) and Senior (HSS and VHSE)).

Time : 2 hrs is allowed for painting competition. Students should bring their own materials for drawing. Paper will be provided by the organiser.

Cultural Competitions {Folk songs (Solo), Folk songs (Group), Folk dance , One act play, Short Video films}

Cultural competitions are conducted for three categories, viz Sub Junior (UP), Junior (HS) and Senior (HSS and VHSE).

A school can send one team each for junior and senior level for different cultural competitions.

Exhibition

Thematic exhibition arranged by the children to display their brilliance in agriculture in the form of appealing exhibits. Each school ought to be on a single theme/idea and cannot be a mix of ideas for setting up exhibition stalls. Working and still-models, Photographs and posters can be setup in an impelling way. Each exhibit shall have the capacity to speak elaborately upon its features, benefits and suitability. Candidate must have the ability to substantiate the highlight of her/his exhibit. School /Students on agricultural initiatives are preferred.

2 tables and 2 chairs will be provided for each team for their exhibits .

Travelling Allowance

TA for participating students is limited to second class sleeper train ticket or bus ticket. Tickets should be produced to claim TA.

Accommodation and Food

Basic accommodation and food will be provided for the participates and accompanying teachers from 18th evening to 20th January 2019.
